

Development of P-16 Performance Indicators and Goals

In 2002, the staffs of the partner agencies of the P-16 Council, in cooperation with local councils, developed a vision statement and an agenda of goals and objectives. These were endorsed by the P-16 Council.

Preliminary indicators and targets of attainment also were proposed by the partner agencies over the following year, drawing on their respective action agenda. A copy of the most recent draft of that document will be distributed to Council members and will be available at the meeting.

Since these earlier discussions, the membership of the P-16 Council has expanded, and three of its partner agencies have jointly proposed the creation of a P-16 data warehouse. Also, the Council on Postsecondary Education, in consultation with several stakeholders, has developed a 2020 Educational Attainment Projections Model to show what it will take on multiple fronts for Kentucky to attain the national average in educational attainment. This model, which encompasses goals including K-12 graduation, GED attainment, Kentucky Community and Technical College System transfer, postsecondary persistence and graduation, and migration of out-of-state baccalaureate degree holders, was presented at the December P-16 Council meeting. Revisiting and updating Kentucky's P-16 progress indicators is both timely and appropriate, given this renewed focus on multi-sector partnerships to attain the shared goal of raising Kentucky's level of educational attainment and workforce readiness.
