

DATA RESOURCES: E⁴ WEB SITE

Information

The E⁴ project is a joint initiative of the Council on Postsecondary Education, the Department for Adult Education and Literacy, the Governor's Office of Early Childhood Development, and the Kentucky Department of Education. The E⁴ initiative emphasizes the connections among the state's education reform efforts.

The title of the E⁴ Web site is "Education, education, education, education: How is Kentucky doing?" E⁴ includes selected performance indicators from early childhood education, elementary and secondary education, adult education, and postsecondary education. It allows visitors to explore the full scope of education reform in the state. Each of the four sections of the site contains graphical representations of educational performance. The primary and secondary section of the site, for instance, contains charts tracking the performance of elementary, middle, and high school students on the CATS assessment. The adult education section highlights the increase in the number of adults receiving GEDs between 1998 and 2001. The site is designed to appeal to a wide audience.
