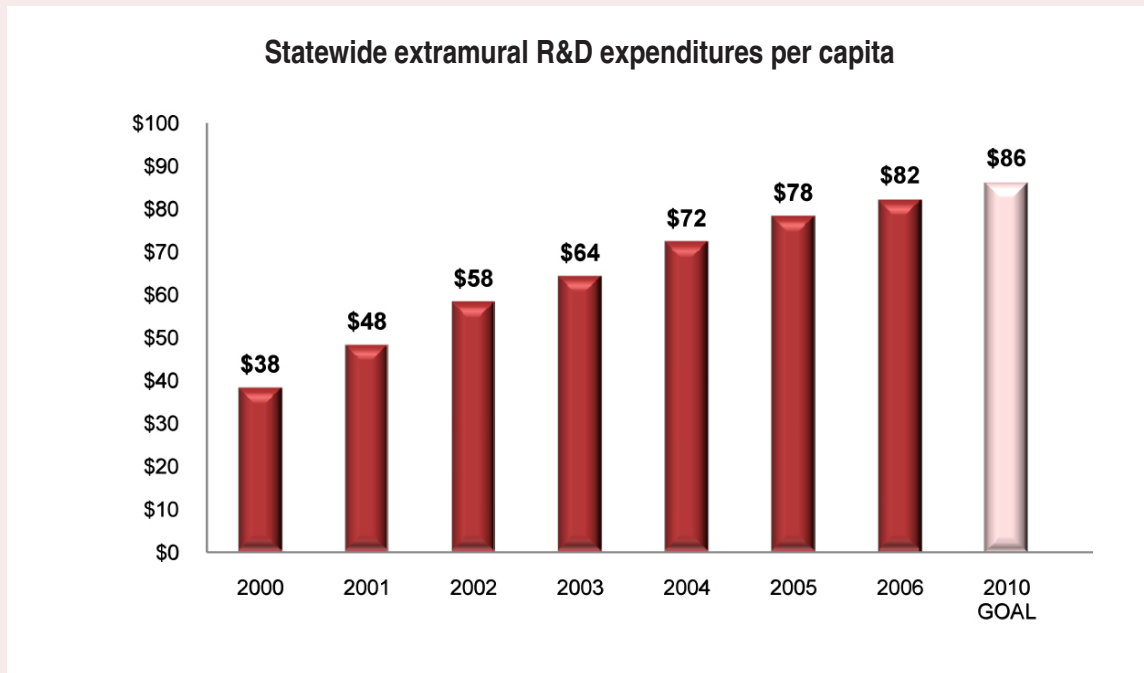




Extramural research and development expenditures per capita

Highlights

- The state has improved R&D expenditures per capita from \$78 in 2005 to \$82 in 2006. Since 2000, Kentucky's performance has increased 116%.

About this measure

This indicator measures total research and development expenditures relative to the state's population, providing for comparisons with other states. The measure is an important index of Kentucky's intellectual capital and potential for economic growth in a global economy.
