Introductions were followed by a brief reminder of future meeting dates in 2025: July 16 and November 20

Harmony Little provided an update on the state's Admissions Redesign Project. The dual credit team has recommended an audit of the current landscape of dual credit courses and instructor availability in Kentucky.

Trinity Walsh, CPE, provided an update on the work of the Dual Credit Community of Practice, which is scheduled to meet again on June 6, 2025.

Becky Gilpatrick provided an update on HB 193 from the legislative session, which clarified language on general education coursework and merged language on dual credit and dual credit work ready scholarships.

The group discussed how to better align dual credit course offerings and scholarship eligibility to CPE's general education core so that course credits are more applicable to degree programs and transferable within Kentucky's postsecondary system.
