2025 Senate Joint Resolution 55

During the 2025 Legislative Session, the Kentucky General Assembly passed Senate Joint Resolution 55, *A JOINT RESOLUTION directing Kentucky's public postsecondary institutions to combat antisemitism*. Section 1 of the resolution directed the governing board of each of Kentucky's public postsecondary education institutions to adopt policies to combat antisemitism by January 1, 2026. The institutions were also directed to collect the following data:

- a) The number of reports alleging antisemitism submitted to the institution, the number of investigations opened by the institution as a result of those reports, and the outcomes of those investigations;
- b) The number of reports alleging violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that are connected to antisemitism of which the institution has been notified and the results of those investigations that are in the possession of the institution; and
- c) The number of actions that have been brought against the institution under KRS 344.450 and the outcomes of such actions.

In accordance with Section 2 of the resolution, each public postsecondary education institution reported the collected data to the Council on Postsecondary Education. As this was the first report, it reviewed available data from the prior two years. The Council on Postsecondary Education compiled the data for each institution and for the state at-large.

NKU received an incident report on October 7, 2024, alleging antisemitism in connection with an on-campus demonstration conducted by an NKU student organization. According to the report, the organization displayed materials during the protest that accused Israel of genocide and apartheid. The reporting student described the materials as defamatory, hateful, and threatening. The matter was reviewed, and NKU determined that the student organization had followed applicable university procedures and that no violation of the NKU Code of Community Standards and Student Rights had occurred.
