KHA Workforce Survey Highlights



- Provides an in-depth review of the non-physician workforce in Kentucky based on members' 2024 data.
- > 91% Participation (115 hospitals)
 - Acute care and specialty hospitals from all Area Development Districts participated in the survey.
- Members are making progress with vacancy rates declining for all health professionals.
 - Statewide hospital workforce vacancy rate of 8.9% compared to 12.0% the prior year (a decrease of almost 2,400 reported vacancies from 2023).

KHA Workforce Survey Highlights - continued



- Hospitals reported lower vacancy rates for RNs at 11.5% compared to 16.5% in 2023.
- Note: A newer workforce is emerging as seasoned staff retire.
 - RNs under the age of 30 account for over ¼ of their hospital profession (26.3%)

Workforce Survey Highlights - Allied Health



Allied Health positions remain an issue for Kentucky's hospitals.

- Respiratory Therapists = 9% Vacancy Rate
- Lab
 - MLS (6%) Vacancy Rate
 - MLT (6%) Vacancy Rate
- Imaging Technicians = 10% Vacancy Rate
 - Cardiac Cath Technicians = 19%
 - MRI Technicians = 13%
 - CT Technicians = 12%
- Surgical Technicians = 16% Vacancy Rate
- Pharmacy Technicians (certified and non-certified) = 6%
- ► Mental Health Technicians = 11%



- Over 1 million media views since initial launch
- Major increase in KHA website traffic November Stats
 - Respiratory Therapy Page Over 4,500 visitors (2nd highest visited page)
 - Workforce Page Over 2,000 visitors (3rd highest visited page)
 - The Hospital Career Website map page had over 500 clicks and hit a record in Oct. with almost 800 clicks
 - Breathe Easy: Your Pathway to a Career as a Respiratory Therapist was downloaded over 50 times


